

Essential Services Committee Notice

On 10 July 2020 the Essential Services Committee (“ESC”) published a notice in terms of section 71, read with section 70(2)(a), of the Labour Relations Act 66 of 1995 (“**LRA**”) (“**Notice**”). In summary, the Notice provides as follows:

1. Notice is given that the ESC is in the process of conducting an investigation, in terms of section 71(B)(1)(d) of the LRA, as to whether the following services are essential:

1. Nutrition/ feeding services at schools;

2. Laundry services in privately owned old age homes;

3. Maintenance Services in the Aviation industry;

4. Ports and Marine Services;

5. Private Security Services; and

6. Private Health Services.
2. Notice is given that an investigation, in terms of section 71(9) of the LRA, on the possible variation of the following designation as an essential service:

1. Key Point Computer Systems.
